Those 1,500 to 2,000 characters represent a basic education level that can help you make it in day-to-day life. The word count is where your Chinese fluency goals come into play . Because Chinese fluency is legally measured by character count, it's assumed that you'd be able to put those characters into words the way we did with the exercise above.

But, there are several facts we need to address before REALLY deciding how many Chinese characters you need to learn: 1. A Chinese character does not equal a 'word' Although a single character does have meaning, most of the time, a 'word' is made up of more than 1 character, usually 2, to make what is called a 'bigram'.

**How Many Chinese Characters Do I Need To Know?**

Learning 3500 characters is not impossible and with proper reviewing and active usage, you can also avoid mixing them up (this is actually the main challenge for non-beginners). Still, 3500 is a massive number. It would mean almost 10 characters per day for a year.
