It later became very popular in the US by the American educator Malcolm Knowles. Knowles asserted that andragogy (Greek: "man-leading") should be distinguished from the more commonly used term pedagogy (Greek: "child-leading"). Knowles collected ideas about a theory of adult education from the end of World War II until he was introduced to the term "andragogy". In 1966, Knowles met Dusan Savicevic in Boston.

Malcolm Knowles recognised the need for lifelong learning and the importance of 'learning how to learn' (Knowles 1970, p. 41). He also saw that educators had begun to respond to the changes in society by experimenting with the way they taught.
