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The Statement on Standards of Professional Conduct prepared by the AHA reminds us that plagiarism "takes many forms." These may include "the limited borrowing, without attribution, of another person's distinctive and significant research findings . . . or an extended borrowing even with attribution."

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Plagiarism deprives writers of the opportunity to join ongoing conversations about a topic. It compromises a writer's integrity and reputation and usually results in serious consequences, both within the university and in the world of work.

In casual conversation, we often associate the word "critical" with a negative perspective. However, in the context of a critical essay, the word "critical" simply means discerning and analytical. Critical essays analyze and evaluate the meaning and significance of a text, rather than making a judgment about its content or quality.
