Once you are approved for Social Security Disability, your case will be periodically reviewed to determine if you are still disabled. These reviews are called continuing disability reviews (CDRs). Social Security sets a review date for every disability claim they approve for benefits. Generally the review dates are set at three or seven years dependent upon the likelihood of medical improvement.

If you have long-term disability benefits, it should be straightforward enough to transition into those benefits if you meet the new definition of disability for your long-term plan. The definition for disability under a long-term plan is typically subtly different than the definition for short-term disability.

You cannot be fired for having an invisible illness covered under the ADA—but you have to be able to do the job you were hired to do. If you can't, your employer is required to make "reasonable accommodations" to help you succeed in your job (see Step 5 below) or find you a lateral move within the company to a vacant job you're qualified for, Center notes.

What Benefits Do You Get From Social Security Disability ...

You have a disability if you have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits your major life activities, such as walking, breathing, seeing, lifting, sleeping, or caring for yourself. Particular diseases or conditions do not "automatically" qualify as disabilities under the ADA; instead, the law looks at how an individual person is actually affected by an impairment.
