APA uses something called a "running head," while the other two styles do not. MLA uses a left-indented topper for the paper author's name, the professor's name, the course name, and date, while MLA and Chicago style do not. So it's important to use the correct style for APA headings when formatting a paper in APA style.

### **Formatting APA Headings and Subheadings**

Basic Format to Follow in APA Outline. Follow this format to avoid errors and more revisions in your research paper or essay. The margins of your paper should be one inch from all sides; left, right, bottom, and top. Your font style should be Times New Roman. Your font size should be 12 pt. Your paragraph space should be double-spaced.

Organize an APA-style document using the five levels of APA headings. Use subheadings when there are at least two subsections within a larger section. Major sections, such as the Method, Results, and Discussion sections, are formatted with the first level of heading.
