These fans then get to keep their "poached" material, although this material has little economic value, it contains its own expressive culture.

The term "textual poaching" was first developed by the French scholar Michel de Certeau in The Practise of Everyday Life (1984) and later developed by Henry Jenkins in Textual poachers: Television Fans and Participatory Culture (1992). De Certeau argues that audiences are not passive consumers but instead active interpreters.
